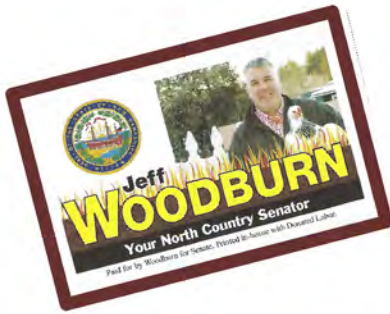
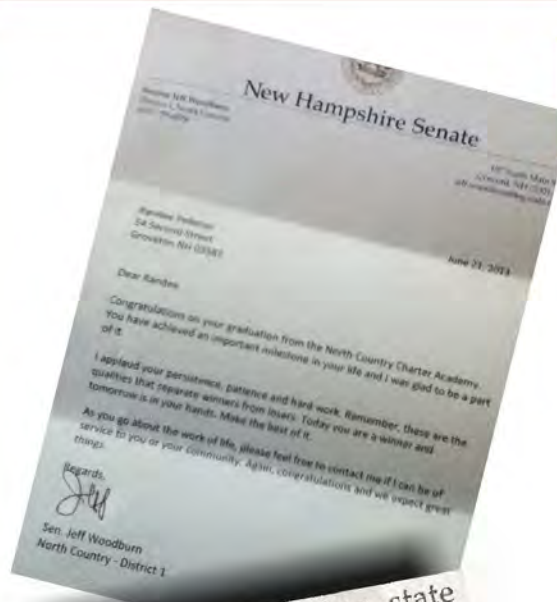


Keynote Speaker - Senator Jeff Woodburn
